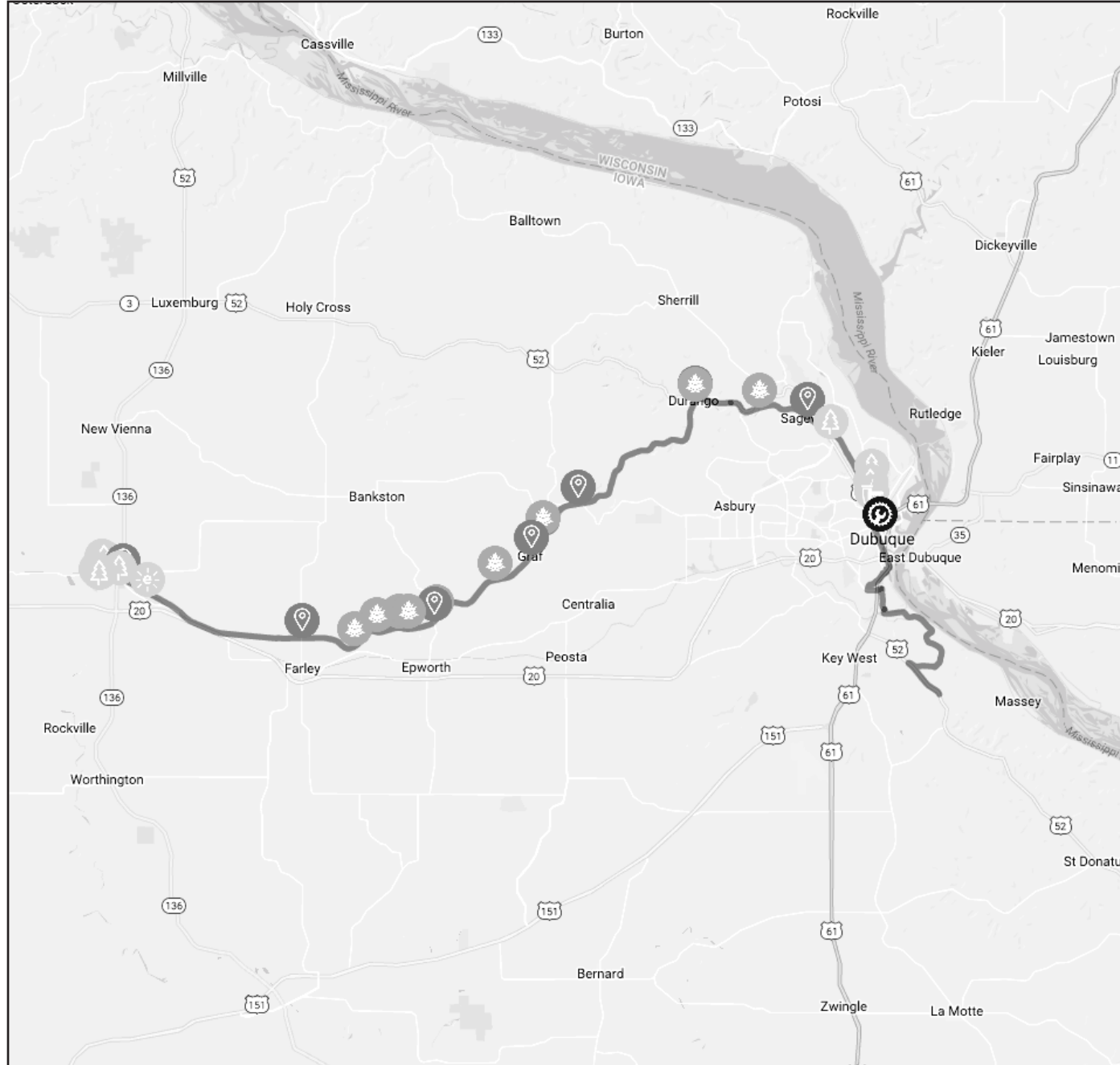


Heritage Trail

TRAIL SURFACE: Crushed limestone

CITIES: Dyersville, Farley, Epworth, Graf, Twin Springs, Budd Road, Durango, Dubuque

DIFFICULTY: Easy

TRAIL DESCRIPTION:

The Heritage Trail gets its name from its rich cultural and natural setting. The 26-mile trail passes through deep rugged woodlands, sheer limestone bluffs, wetland communities and prairies. Because it follows the former Chicago Northwestern rail bed from Dyersville to Dubuque, there are also traces of old mining and mill towns.
